



All RTC eligible athlete of any age level are welcome to join come to Columbus and train with the Ohio RTC at any and all RTC practices at no cost.

An athlete is RTC Eligible as long as he/she fits into at least one of the following categories and is an athlete member of USA Wrestling:

- a. Placed top 4 at the High School State Championship
- b. Placed top 4 at the Prep National Championships
- c. Placed top 4 at USAW State Junior freestyle/Greco-Roman Championships
- d. Placed top 4 at USAW State Cadet freestyle/Greco-Roman Championships
- e. Placed top 4 at USAW Senior Regional
- f. Won at least one match at a USAW World or Olympic Team Trials
- g. Placed top 8 at USAW Senior Open Championships
- h. Placed top 8 at USAW University National Championship
- i. Placed top 8 at UWW Junior National Championship
- j. Placed top 8 at USAW Junior National Championship
- k. Placed top 8 at USAW Cadet National Championship
- l. Placed top 4 at New York Athletic Club International
- m. Placed top 4 at Dave Schultz Memorial International
- o. Any veteran athlete who has represented the U.S. within the last two years at the Veteran's World Championships or is scheduled to compete at the next world championship event

All wrestlers participating in the RTC practice must meet one of the above criteria and must be current athlete members of USA Wrestling.

*International athletes/coaches who currently represent a country other than the U.S. may attend on a limited basis based on approval of the National Governing Body and RTC. These individuals must be of similar competitive caliber. These individuals may attend on an intermittent basis in order to enhance national team development.
